

MINUTES OF THE PUBLIC HEARING

ON THE 85.21 SPECIALIZED TRANSPORTATION ASSISTANCE GRANT FROM THE WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION HELD ON THURSDAY, DECEMBER 10, 2009

AT THE VILAS COUNTY COURTHOUSE

EAGLE RIVER, WISCONSIN

The Public Hearing was opened at 9:00 a.m. by the Commission on Aging Chairman Erv Teichmiller. 
