### **Armed Robbery – St. Germain Pharmacy**

#### **Monday, March 29, 2010, St. Germain, Wisconsin: Two Suspects arrested in St. Germain Armed Robbery**

On Monday, March 29, 2010 at approximately 10:50am, the Vilas County Sheriff's Office received a 911 call from the St. Germain Pharmacy reporting an armed robbery. While the caller was on the phone with the dispatcher, the suspects fled northbound in a maroon or dark red Dodge mini-van.

It was reported that an unknown female entered the pharmacy and demanded narcotic medication. The female displayed a firearm. The female left the pharmacy and entered a maroon or dark red Dodge min-van driven by an unknown male. The two traveled north on STH 70 to STH 155 northbound.

No one at the pharmacy was hurt. The suspect(s) fled with narcotic medications.

All law enforcement in the area responded to the area. After securing a perimeter officers began to search the area for the suspect vehicle.

At 11:56am, officers located the suspect vehicle. At approximately 12:10pm suspect(s) were taken into custody without incident.

Arrested are 53 year old female from Eagle River, WI and a 55 year old male from Eagle River, WI.

Law enforcement responding and assisting in this investigation include Boulder Junction Police Department, Lac du Flambeau Tribal Police, Oneida County Sheriff's Office, Woodruff Police Department, Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources State Forest Rangers, Vilas County Sheriff's Office.

This incident was able to be resolved with the great cooperation of our area law enforcement and coordination of our joint response.

It is still early in this investigation. The defendants are expected to appear in Vilas County Court on Tuesday March 30, 2010.


